

Visitors to Eklavya campus

There are three types of visitors to Eklavya, guidelines to each is detailed here:

1. For Admissions
2. School Management, Trustees, Principals and School Teachers who want to see Eklavya school
3. Others

1. For Admissions:

Parents are permitted to visit the school only after submitting the filled-in Admission form. Filling in the Admission form is possible only when admissions are open and if there is a vacancy in the class you are seeking admission for. This is normally during the months of October, November and December.

Once the form is submitted, as a potential parent you are welcome to visit the school from Monday to Saturday between 9am and 12noon. For visiting the school please send an e-mail one week in advance of the date of your visit to eklavya@eklavya.org stating the purpose of the visit, proposed date and names of people visiting.

You are welcome to visit the campus only after receiving a confirmation to your e-mail.

As soon as you reach the campus please meet the receptionist. She will give you a 'Self guided tour map' of Eklavya and the guidelines for visitors. Please read the guidelines carefully before you begin your visit. You may follow the map and take a tour of the campus.

2. School Management , Trustees, Principals and School Teachers who want to see Eklavya school:

The following are the 'Open Days' in Eklavya School, in the academic year 2024-25:
Nov 18, 19 and 20 (Mon-Wed) 2024

During these days, any teacher/principal from any school in India is welcome to visit Eklavya. There is no charge for this. Ideally they should spend all three days, Mon-Wed, where a detailed exposure programme is arranged, conducted by Senior Teachers and Principals, basically covering - all the practices in Eklavya, what we do, how we do.

This programme is over three days, so anyone visiting for a part of the three days will miss out on certain exposure.

It is a very exhaustive programme, covering Pre School to Senior School, in great detail, and the people conducting it put-in a lot of effort to make it worthwhile for the participants.

Often some young people, who want to start a school of their own, come for this exposure, since many of their questions get addressed completely, and mind becomes clear.

You are welcome to join. You have to write an e-mail specifying name of your organisation, which city, who all are coming, and give name/age/sex/which class which subject/etc of the people coming to help us ensure that his/her area is fully addressed. You have to make your own stay arrangements, transport and lunch in school will be arranged by Eklavya

(If these dates are not convenient, you are welcome to visit Eklavya any other time suitable to you - and of course confirmed by us - but please note that in such cases Eklavya may not be able to arrange an Educator/Principal/responsible person to show you around and address queries. in such a case - frankly speaking - maza nahin aayega)

3. Others:

For the safety and security of the students and educators we do not encourage visitors on the campus.

However if someone is very keen on visiting the campus, the person has to send a detailed email, one week in advance of the date of your visit to eklavya@eklavya.org, with the purpose of the visit, along with the details of the people who will be visiting – how many members, name, age, how related to the person who is seeking permission. You will also need to mention the date and duration of your visit.
